Bucket List

- See what Fat Margaret Tower is about
- Climb to the top of St. Olav's Church (in 1267 it's claimed to be the tallest building in the world - 2 Euro for tower open:10-20)
 - Visit the Holy Spirit Church (between Pikk and the Town Sq)
 - Explore St. Catherine's Passage (Katariina Kaik - between Vene and Muurvahe off of Town Sq. by Pharmacy)
- Go back in time and climb the towers and city wall (Nunna, Sauna and Kuldjala towers - northwest corner of Old Towne & to see the wall from the outside go to Patkuli viewing platform on Toompea and Tornide väljak (Towers' Square).)
- Observe the Russian-orthodox influence at St. Alexander Nevsky Cathedral and listen to the bells ring
 - Is there really a pink castle? Toompea Castle (Toompea Loss)
 - Take in the view from Patkul or Court sq. lookout (city & sea)
